## **Eta State and DKG International Scholarships Available**

One of the benefits of Delta Kappa Gamma membership is the opportunity to receive scholarships for advanced degrees. Eta State sponsors \$4,000 academic scholarships for either Master's level work requiring graduate school enrollment or non-activities such as special projects, research, or certifications.

International awards up to 30 scholarships annually in the amount of \$6,000 for Master Degree candidates and \$10,000 to Doctoral Degree candidates. Applications, deadlines, and eligibility can be found on the DKG and state website under the Scholarship Committee link. Eta State members may apply for both an Eta State and an International Scholarship within a given year.
