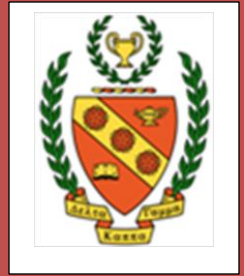

Directions to Siler Presbyterian Church Fellowship Hall from Monroe, Wingate and Marshville:

Because of Highway 84 (Weddington) Road construction, it would be best to follow Old Charlotte Highway to Sun Valley High School. At Sun Valley High School, turn left at Stouts Road. Proceed on Stouts Road until you reach a "round about" and take a right on Wesley Chapel-Stouts Road. Proceed on this road, until you reach a stoplight at Highway 84 (Weddington Road), then turn right into Weddington Road (Highway 84) proceed approximately three miles. Siler Presbyterian Church will be located at the next stoplight. Turn right at the stoplight, and proceed to the white and green sign-turn right and follow a short winding road to the back of the fellowship hall. (There is a drop-off at the building and a circle driveway back to the parking lot.

Directions to Siler Presbyterian Church Fellowship Hall from Huntersville:

Merge into I-77S and take Exit 18 for James G. Martin Freeway/I485 toward Pineville/Huntersville

Keep right at the fork to continue toward I 485 and take Exit 1B on the left for Martin Freeway/I 485 E toward Pineville

Merge into I- 485 and take Exit 57 for North Carolina 16/Providence Road toward Weddington. Turn right onto NC -16 S/Providence Road. Take the left onto Weddington Road (Weddington Methodist Church will be on the right at this stoplight).

At the traffic circle, continue straight onto NC-84/Weddington Road. Proceed approximately four miles and turn left onto Waxhaw-Indian Trail Road. Take the second driveway on your right to the fellowship building parking area.

Directions to Siler Presbyterian Church Fellowship Hall from Concord:

Proceed on I 485 South and take Exit 52 toward Matthews. Turn left onto East John Street and then right onto Potter Road. At the traffic circle, take the 1st exit onto Waxhaw-Indian Trail Road and proceed approximately two miles. When you approach a housing development on the left and a shopping area on your right, take the next left to enter the fellowship hall parking lot. (There is a white and green sign and a short winding road to the back of the fellowship hall.

If you have a GPS in your vehicle our address at Siler is 6301 Weddington-Monroe Road, Wesley Chapel, NC. Tommie Wall's cell phone number is 704-572-8465, if you need assistance.
